Dear Parents and Carers,

In the past two weeks we have had several occasions where students have contacted home when they are feeling unwell without following the proper channels. Please can we ask for your support with ensuring that your child is aware that, if they feel unwell, they must go to student reception in order for school to contact home on their behalf. We do make every attempt to keep our students in school and learning wherever possible. Our expectation is that if students have been sent into school in the morning, they are well enough to remain in school for the full school day, unless there is an incident in school or a serious health concern.

If you feel that your child is not well enough to be in school in the morning, please keep them at home and ring the student absence line. Colleagues who work in the student reception area have received basic first-aid training but are not trained medical professionals. I must also remind you that students are not allowed to use their phones during the school day. Our guidelines clearly state that phones should not be seen, heard or used between the hours of 8.40am and 2.50pm. If a student uses their phone during the day, their phone will be confiscated and kept in the student

reception until the end of the school day. Thanks so much for your continuing support with this.
