Dear Parents and Carers,

On Tuesday this week I attended an event at the Town Hall regarding the ongoing cost of living crisis. The event allowed opportunities for Todmorden High School to network with organisations across sectors we hadn't met before, begin work closely with other local organisations to support the community of Todmorden and offer feedback to the council on our own experiences of how the crisis is affecting our young people and their families. We are very aware of the impact the current cost of living may be having on many of you and we are here to help if you need us. Please don't hesitate to get in touch with me or a member of our school team if you are experiencing financial difficulties and need some guidance or support. There are several provisions in Todmorden to support families with accessing food packages should they need them; please take a look at the links I outline below for information:

- <u>Calder Community Cares Food Share Project</u> (The Food Share Project can provide food parcels in an emergency, call 0790 3452 788)
- <u>The Old Library Cornholme, Food Bank & Cafe</u> (The Old Library at Cornholme runs a drop in Food Bank which is open every Monday 1030-12pm)
- <u>Kindness Cafe</u> (The Kindness Cafe serves delicious and nutritious food and operates a 'pay it forward' scheme that allows customers to donate a meal)
- <u>Todmorden Food Drop in</u> (Open Saturdays at Tod College. Free food parcels, advice and support, hot drinks and food served when open)
- <u>Home Simply Veg</u> Advice and guidance on introducing more veg into young people's diets while still keeping meals affordable.

We also have a stock of uniform. Do please let us know if you need any support. All requests will be dealt with confidentially and sensitively.
