## Home Learning



Home learning plays a crucial role in reinforcing and extending the learning that takes place in the classroom. It is a valuable tool that enhances your child's overall academic experience and contributes

significantly to their success. Home learning at Todmorden High School provides students with the opportunity to reinforce what they have learned in class. It serves as a practice session, helping them consolidate their understanding of new concepts and skills. The knowledge based tasks set on GCSE Pod, Carousel, Isaac Physics, Educake and SPARX are specifically designed to enhance complex thinking within the classroom.

These online learning platforms have the added benefit of instant feedback and support videos. Educational research shows that home learning increases student progress by five moths on average. It provides a structured way to complete revision for upcoming assessments and builds good habits for success in the GCSE examinations. Finally, home learning provides teachers with insights into each student's understanding of the material that has been taught. This feedback loop enables teachers to identify areas where additional support may be needed, ensuring that students receive the help they require to succeed.

Should your child require any support with completion of home learning, they are more than welcome to attend home learning club after school in the library.

If you are taking a holiday during term time, please do not assume home learning is waivered. Any questions, please contact your child's form teacher. Many thanks.

## Parking at the beginning and end of the day.



At the beginning and end of the day, we have 950 students coming onto and leaving our site. We need to keep them safe at these times. There are always staff out keeping them safe from moving cars, operating the crossing so they cross Burnley Road safely and getting them to the pavement on Ewood Lane safely. In addition to this we want to work with our neighbours around school to minimise the impact on them. We have recently had more cars parking on Ewood Lane to drop off and pick up students and we know the residents of this narrow road find the traffic at these times frustrating. The Hare and Hounds car park has been in use by TV crews recently and this has put additional pressure on also.

We would like to remind all parents and carers that the safety of our students is paramount and ask all of you who drive to your children to school park respectfully and in line with the parking restrictions around school. We strongly advise you to avoid driving up Ewood Lane as it is narrow and easily congested. If frustration with others occurs please show respect for each other, our staff and the legal restrictions and road markings in the area.
