#### Dear Parents and Carers,

Good attendance at school is essential in ensuring your child achieves their potential. Our summer results showed our students with attendance above 95% made significantly greater progress than other students with similar starting points across the country. Although we do recognise there are occasions where a child may be unwell and not fit to attend school, we have an increasing number of students arriving in school and then presenting themselves to first aid feeling unwell. Please be aware we are encouraging children who may be slightly under the weather to remain in school where possible. If you believe your child is too unwell to attend school, please keep them at home and ring the student absence line. If we need to contact you about your child, it is your decision as to whether you collect them or they stay in school. If you choose to collect your child, the register will be marked in the same way as if you had called the absence line that day.

Please take a look at our extra-curricular offer at the rear of this letter. We hold a wide range of clubs for students to attend after school and enrich their educational experience. If your child does not currently attend a club please share this with them and encourage them to join one. All clubs begin at 3pm.



The weather is worsening as we move firmly into the Autumn term. At the start of this academic year, we adjusted the way we select and support students for what we have previously called 'intervention' or 'revision' sessions after school. Our targeted academic support programme means we are using the information from students' assessments and specifically planning a series of sessions that are intended to close a knowledge gap for the students selected or support them in practising a skill that is key to the examination specification. These sessions are intended to support our school vision of unlocking the unique potential of every student.



This means that being invited to one of these groups will not necessarily mean that the student is not doing well in that subject, rather that we believe that they could, with a short, tailored period of intervention, do even better. The selections for the groups are made by our curriculum leaders based on assessment information. The sessions run in a period 6 slot that shows on the student's timetable. If your child is invited to one of these sessions, you will receive a class charts notification and a letter explaining the subject and reason they have been selected. The letter will also ask you to confirm your child's attendance, so we and you know where they are at these times. We are delighted to have appointed a new Head Chef/Catering Manager, Miss Dearden. Due to an increased uptake in school dinners we are moving to three lunch sittings from Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September to accommodate this. The additional lunch sitting will allow for shorter lunch queues and more available seating for the students.

There are two key changes. Firstly year 7 will have their lesson split in half with lunch in the middle. Secondly year 9 will eat their lunch in the hall rather than the canteen.
