Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your continued support during the strike days. Staff have been working hard to ensure that Year 10 and 11 are fully supported throughout these days and it has worked well in school. Please do encourage your Year 11 child to attend as many catch up sessions as possible over the coming weeks in the lead up to them sitting their exams - a number of GCSE teachers across school hold regular sessions after school and at lunch times for students. Please can I remind parents that false nails, eyelashes, nail polish and heavy makeup are not permitted in school. Please do not send your child to school with any of the above, as students will be asked to remove them and will be sanctioned if they refuse. You may notice some of our detentions have changed. We're moving from individual detentions to a centralised system. Our SLT and extended SLT detentions will remain in place on Thursday and Friday's after school.

We'd like some feedback regarding a change to our school day. From Sept 2023 the times of our school day will change slightly; we will expect students on-site from 8:30am and the day will finish at 3:00pm. This move will allow us to increase social time for students and will ensure we are compliant with the expectation of a 32.5-hour week. 2. **Girls Allowed** at Calder Holmes Park on Fridays from 28 April 2023. Girls only, from 5.30 pm, ages 11+. When women and girls feel unsafe, they are less likely to use, enjoy and benefit from parks, particularly when alone and after dark. Parks and play spaces should be designed and managed to be well-used, sociable places that offer activities and facilities that are welcoming to women and girls. Changes should support women and girls to feel safe throughout the day and all-year round. Changes to parks must be part of a holistic approach that tackles threats of violence against women and girls, to address root causes of risks to women and girls. Please see flyers at rear of this letter.

Our sessions with girls will explore why they feel unsafe in our park and in public places and will support them to develop strategies and behaviours that will help keep them safe. We will be working with our partners, Skate it Yourself, Branching Out and The Maggie Oliver Foundation to cover sexual harassment, risk assessment, the role of drugs and alcohol, sexual health, and child sexual exploitation. We will be providing a full programme of activities to support our aims.

We will also be working separately with boys who wish to support the safety of girls.

We will be in Calder Holmes Park from 5-30pm each week. You can just turn up and sign up then or you can call Liz Anstee on 0771 333 8698 [project coordinator] to find out more info. Watch this space for more information about our project. Some sessions will have age restrictions.

3. **Basketball club** at Todmorden Community College. Mr Charles and Miss Ashley-Walsh are working with Todmorden Community College to deliver basketball sessions to 11–15-year-olds in the community. Please see the flyer below for more information If your child would like to attend these sessions. Consent forms can be found at student reception in school.
