ARCH Updates

- Half-way through the year . . . where are we?
 - 404 students have attendance greater than 96%
 - 297 students still have an ARCH ratio of 100%.
 - 532 students have an ARCH ratio above 96%.
 - 50% more home-learning is being submitted than last year.
 - Lates to lesson have reduced on average by over 1/3 since last year.


