Review of previous minutes	<p>Catherine Bann talked about ‘Esteemed Creatives’ are looking to expand and develop the youth provision in Todmorden. Looking for funding. Meeting arranged to set out a MOA and look at how they can apply for funding.</p> <p>Becca Wagstaff has been into school to speak with students and now looking for students to get involved. Funded by the police as crime prevention through engagement. Bringing together people impacted by antisocial behaviour, perpetrators of antisocial behaviour and services involved.</p>

Great Summer Get Together	On the 21 st June. GSH invited the group to the event. There will be food/talent competition. Opportunity for community to get together.
Patients Participation Group at Todmorden Group Practice – Campaign for minor Surgery Unit at Todmorden Health Centre	<p>Facilities already exist in the Health Centre for minor surgery unit. Upstairs is currently vacant. PFI contract finishes in four years’ time.</p> <p>Proposing a minor injuries unit. Looking to present a case for how much demand there is for this sort of service. GSH will provide some figures from school to support this.</p>
Any other business	<p>150th Anniversary of Todmorden Town Hall – end of March 2025. Funding has been secured to have a town wide celebration over the course of a week. Launch event in September 2024. Would like to do assemblies in school, to share information and to talk to them about getting involved.</p> <p>Gill updated on the project that Colin Hill has been leading on the Todmorden Bandstand. Buttress Architects have been into school to talk to all students in assemblies. 18 students have been working with firm – great for careers/raising ambitions. The school will also be involved in sorting a timeline to go around the space during the renovation.</p> <p>Amna Nisah has been in touch about ‘plan it’ – doing a revamp of the market space. Architects coming into school to talk to another group of students in relation to this.</p> <p>PC Fleming commented that there has been a significant reduction in calls for ASB.</p> <p>Diana and Ken White have a meeting with First Buses about the poor provision in the upper Calder valley.</p>
