You may recall my mentioning in a previous letter that Megan Shaw (one of our pupils) was successful in achieving the place of runner up in the Calderdale Jubilee Plaque competition. The competition saw school pupils across Calderdale submit hundreds of creative and innovative entries which were designed as a lasting tribute to Her Majesty The Queen.

The winners and runners-up were revealed in a special ceremony on Sunday 5 June, the final day of the four-day historic Jubilee celebrations at The Piece Hall. The West Yorkshire representative of Her Majesty, Lord Lieutenant Ed Anderson, presented the certificates of achievement.



This Sunday there is a Jubilee Picnic in the park. Another chance to celebrate the Jubilee, mark 70 years of Tod history and celebrate Father's Day.

Tod High school pupils with Music for the Many will be performing as part of a cast of 100 children and adults! There will be the premiere performance of a piece written to capture the history of Tod, Jubilee's past, and memories of Centre Vale Park. The whole event will be filmed and recorded for posterity.

We have been informed by Calderdale Public Health that there have recently been a small number of confirmed cases of a rare strain of meningitis B in the OL14 postcode area, tragically leading to the death of a member of our community. As a precautionary measure Calderdale are offering everyone who lives in the OL14 area and is between the ages of 16-24, or in year 11 at school, a vaccination to protect themselves. Information nationally suggests that the risk is higher in this group. Only people who have been invited will be able to get the vaccination. There is nothing to suggest any setting-based links between cases and settings, so it is unlikely that students or staff are at any risk of developing meningitis from attending school. 

2022 Virtual TCS London Marathon

Sunday 2nd October

An ideal option for people who want to do something amazing for charity, but didn't get a place in the mass event, aren't able to travel to London, or need a little longer to complete the 26.2 miles.

Everyone will take part on the same day. 40,000 participants of the virtual TCS London Marathon and 50,000 participants at the London Marathon in London.

What it's all about...

- Healthy Minds has been awarded twelve places in this year's virtual TCS London Marathon.
- All registered finishers will receive their coveted medal and New Balance finisher t-shirt on successful completion.
- Participants can run, walk, or jog. Just cover the distance of 26.2 miles, that's all that counts.
- The route can be anywhere within Calderdale. Do it YOUR WAY. From a fun fancy dress skip round a building idea to a gruelling fell run.
- Participants will have 23 hours, 59 minutes and 59 seconds to complete the distance. This must be on Sunday 2nd October (00:00:00 to 23:59:59).
- Participants will receive an official running number before the event.
- An official virtual TCS London Marathon app will allow participants to track their 26.2 miles.
- The app will enable the runner/walker to pause/resume the tracking so that they can take a break, stop and start as much as they like. The app will record their moving time.
- Opportunity for other walkers/runners to get involved. For example:
 - Participants complete each mile with a group of different friends/walkers.
 - A group walk with the participant for the full 26.2 miles.
- These twelve virtual London Marathon places are valuable to Healthy Minds. Each, a perfect fundraising opportunity. There is no minimum fundraising commitment, but we would ask that you raise as much as you possibly can. Support, advice, and publicity of involvement will be provided.
- Entrants must be 18 years or over on Sunday 2nd October.
