With changes to national guidance taking effect from Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January, Calderdale have written to you, our parents and carers, to update you on what this means for COVID measures and your children. From Monday 31<sup>st</sup> of January the wearing of face masks will be optional for students and staff. We will support any student who chooses to continue to wear a mask as we are aware that this change may be concerning or make students apprehensive.

A reminder of our uniform expectations. Students are permitted to wear a single plain stud in each ear, no other piercings are allowed. If your child's school shoes break mid-week, they will be offered a pair of our clean shoes to wear for the day. If this is unacceptable to you, please have a spare pair of shoes available at home. Thanks to all who attended my virtual parent drop in this week. It was a pleasure to speak to some of our parents and to answer queries or concerns that have popped up throughout the first term. I use the parent drop in as a forum to gather valuable feedback and then act upon this feedback to make wider school improvements. I am hosting my next virtual drop in on the Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> February, 3pm.

Our first Parent Governor Forum of the year is on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> February from 6-7pm. We are intending to hold the event on site, in our school hall. You will be able to attend via main reception. Tea and coffee will be provided. If the meeting has to be changed to a virtual format I will ensure I notify you in advance. The Parent Governor Forum is an excellent opportunity to meet with Senior Leaders and members of our Governing Body to discuss school wide issues and ask any questions you might have. I look forward to seeing some of you there, we are really pleased to be able to host this event in person after a long time of meeting virtually.

As many of you will be aware we have an invacuation and evacuation procedure in school that we use to protect and safeguard our students in the case that;

- someone comes on to school site threatening our students and staff e.g. carrying a weapon (invacuation);
- there is an issue inside the building that means students need to vacate the area (evacuation).

We will be running routine drills for these two procedures in the coming weeks to ensure that students know what to do if an incident were to arise.

- Invacuation drill will take place Monday 14<sup>th</sup> February at 13:15pm.
- Evacuation drill will take place Friday 18<sup>th</sup> February at 14:45.

As such students will leave school 5 minutes early on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> February as part of the drill evacuation of the school building. Students will be informed and prepared in their assemblies before the date.
